

PURPOSE:

To eliminate no-shows from TMS conferences.

PROCEDURE:

For the TMS Annual Meeting & Exhibition and other TMS-sponsored specialty conferences, individuals who are designated as a presenter of an accepted oral or poster presentation must do one of the following:

- 1. attend the meeting and deliver the presentation
- 2. notify staff of the intent to cancel 60 days prior to the start of the meeting
- 3. arrange for the presentation to be delivered by a substitute presenter

If none of these actions are taken, the presenter will be designated as a no-show.

In all cases, presenters should notify TMS and their symposium organizers immediately upon determination that they cannot attend and present their talk.

PENALTY: A presenter who is a no-show for one or more oral or poster presentations at a single meeting will receive a warning. If the speaker no-shows again within three years, they will be suspended from giving a presentation in any format for the next two years.

APPEAL: Extenuating circumstances can be evaluated via appeal to the sponsoring division's Program Representatives, provided that some advance notice of the cancellation was given by the presenter to TMS.
